Progress has been made in identifying the aims and purposes of public high schools; less progress, in determining the means of achieving these goals. Much relevant research has been done, not alone by professional educators, but also by those in related disciplines such as psychology and educational sociology. Yet, research findings and expert opinions, incomplete and imperfect as they are, are not affecting high school practices to the extent that they should. In some high schools, teachers are still trying to do for all American youth what was done fifty years ago to equip them for college and university. In other high schools, changes in curriculum and instruction have been made, but programs are not well coordinated, graduates of average ability are not adequately prepared either for effective...



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
